This letter responds to your inquiry regarding products manufactured by Calumet and its subsidiary companies in relation to **Conflict Minerals**, as regulated by the **Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act Section 1502** and the **Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) Conflict Minerals Rule 13p**.

#### **Definition of Conflict Minerals**

Under Dodd-Frank Section 1502(e)(4), Conflict Minerals are defined as:

- **(A)** Columbite-tantalite (coltan), cassiterite, gold, wolframite, or their derivatives (currently limited to tantalum, tin, and tungsten); or
- **(B)** Any other mineral or derivative determined by the U.S. Secretary of State to be financing conflict in the **Covered Countries**.

#### **Covered Countries include:**

1. Democratic Republic of the Congo
2. Republic of South Sudan
3. Republic of Congo
4. Central African Republic
5. Republic of Uganda
6. Republic of Rwanda
7. Republic of Burundi
8. Republic of Angola
9. United Republic of Tanzania
10. Republic of Zambia

#### **Calumet's Position**

In compliance with SEC reporting requirements, Calumet confirms that Conflict Minerals are not necessary to the functionality or production of Calumet products and are not intentionally used in any Calumet manufacturing processes.
