This letter is regarding your recent inquiry regarding our petrolatum and mineral oil product compliance to Directive (EU) 2015/863 of March 2015 amending Annex II to Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2011 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS).

The RoHS 3 Directive restricts the use of the following ten substances:

- 1. Lead (Pb)
- 2. Mercury (Hg)
- 3. Cadmium (Cd)
- 4. Hexavalent Chromium [Cr(VI)]
- 5. Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)
- 6. Polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE)
- 7. Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)
- 8. Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)
- 9. Bis (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)
- 10. Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP)

Our USP-NF grade white mineral oil and USP petrolatum products are in full compliance with this directive.
